We deeply appreciate all prayers, love, and support. We are so grateful that you have been standing with us, in these challenging times, we are also encouraged to share porting of our support with other fellow workers who having challenging moments as well, thank you and as you read our report we hope that will see how much you very intricate part of all that Lord is doing in and through the ministry of missions. Thank you for being missionaries with us through all that you do.

As you are aware we had been apart for 2 years 9 months and 2 weeks. We have so many challenging moments such as the passing away of Maria's Mom, then if not enough Pedayah breaking His leg, and then the situation of Henry almost losing His eyes, we found out that Abigail has scoliosis in the upper part of her spine. Maria has had challenges on the deterioration of her jaw bones right under some of the tooth sections. In all these challenges. God has been so faithful throughout the process. God has restored Henry's eyes, Pedayah's broken is almost completely healed, and we trust God for a miracle for Maria and Abigail.

Maria continues faithfully with the homeschooling of our two youngest boys, and also ministering in a bible study in our neighborhood, as well as meeting with Christian women to counsel and encourage them in family, marriage, and life in general. Henry has returned from the USA from officiating a wedding ceremony, ministering in Pennsylvania, and Oklahoma to further the partnership of missions around the world and encouraging the pioneering efforts of a Latin church. Also, our daughter Abigail took her GED test and past it with flying colors. We were able encourage several people as times are very challenging

We have continued to serve here on the island of Barbados in the context of Maria's home church in evangelism by going to the community near the Church. We also promote missions through teaching and encouraging more mission involvement. This coming summer the church will be taking a team the Malawi, Africa. I (Henry) will be going with the team to assist them in how we function as a team and doing missions with them, the goal of this trip is to open more doors into other countries in Africa, doing the same in all the continents.

Ministry through the internet is going, every day providing teaching on various topics to the body of Christ, as well as networking with other mission's organizations like Operational Mobilization, teaching, sharing, and informing about the persecuted church, missions on a global scale, and prayer network for both situation around the world like Haiti. Also continually share with my Asian friends, about God's love for them, counseling, and the basics of the faith while maintaining my other languages. We also

often advise, counsel, and teach fellow missionaries online. This coming April will be teaching leadership to missionaries in the Philippines.
