



DAY CAMP 2024: THANK YOU so much for praying! God blessed us with 119 campers (13 first-timers!) who came to one of our NINE three-day camp sessions – our fourth Day Camp summer – and this year back on our Akron Ministry Center with a tent pitched behind our office. God provided 43 summer staffers or volunteers who served as Counselors, Support Staffers, Housekeeping, Activities Assistants, Assistant Nurses, Lunch Makers, kidsitters and Saturday fill-in helpers. There were 14 HVMI staffers who served in leadership and some of those other same positions. The uniqueness of day camp (no dressing, changing into swim suits, etc.) gave us the option again of having gal staffers work with guy campers and vice versa if needed. I was a Counselor during two of the sessions and pitched in as needed during others. God blessed us with some new staffers thanks to recruiting visits to several colleges at various times through the year. Chris Fletcher has already connected with some key leadership students at LBC that could lead to future connections for recruiting camp staff and local Bible Club volunteers. He has a Camp Fair at Liberty University Oct 1-2 that he'll be part of. Pray for God to continue to provide all the people we need to help ministry happen throughout the year and next summer.

Our Day Camp Bible theme was "Bible 'Lympics – God's Winning Ways." Tara Kelley and Meghan Martin taught chapels in various sessions using Bible skits and lots of good worship songs. Campers divided into Bible class table groups to reinforce the learning after chapels. Elective activities included rocketry, gardening, Giant UNO, crafts, puppets, music/choir, basketball, drama, goofy golf, Disney sing-along, archery,





worship and fishing twice each session (campers loved that we were back at our fishing pond this summer!). We enjoyed large group activities – baseball, parachute activities, campfire at our new fire pit area (s'mores and silly songs), water games (to help beat the heat of the HOT, dry days we had) and Handi 'Lympic Games each session (it is an Olympic year so we joined in with our own version). We had yummy lunches each camp day and friends brought suppers for our staffers, too. We added more accessibility to the original clubhouse building

(bathrooms and covered deck area) and that building became our snack shop which camper enjoyed two afternoons each session. Nurses had their work area inside our new office and we had a changing room in there, too. Campers and staffers had a great time each session and God blessed in many ways. Pray for the lasting impact of God's Word in hearts and lives of campers and staffers alike. Looking back at our four summers of Day Camp, we've had 85 first-time campers! Many have returned in following years and some are also connecting in our monthly Bible Clubs. Thank the Lord for this growth in the impact of our ministry, especially with local families.
